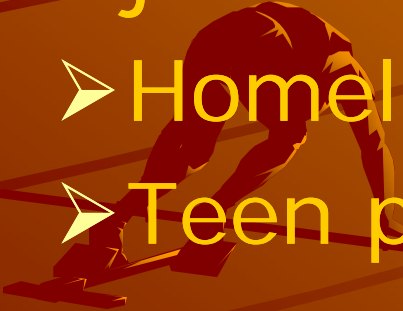


Project SUCCESS Presents: Working 4 SUCCESS Academy
