Stanislaus County Office of Education, Riverbank Unified School District, Turlock Unified School District, and AVID have coordinated with local colleges, universities, technical schools, and other community organizations to come together and provide information to parents and students regarding college admissions criteria, financial aid, and what classes students need to take in order to be prepared for college. The presentations are conducted in both English and Spanish simultaneously. This event is free to the community.

Each middle and high school bordering the hosting site will receive approximately six (6) posters; three (3) in English and three (3) in Spanish. We request that these posters be placed in high foot traffic areas for student visibility. Additionally, you will receive a parent letter and a flyer, per the number of enrollment (2007) for grades 6 through 12. The letter and flyer (which are in English & Spanish) are to inform students and parents of these events therefore we ask that you distribute them to the students in a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> period class. AVID classes will receive additional posters and handouts.

Schools will also be receiving a scripted message, provided by the Stanislaus County Office of Education. This message may be used with the school's auto dial system (if available) to notify parents of the event both one week prior and the evening prior to the events.
