## State BTSA Online Consent Form Registration

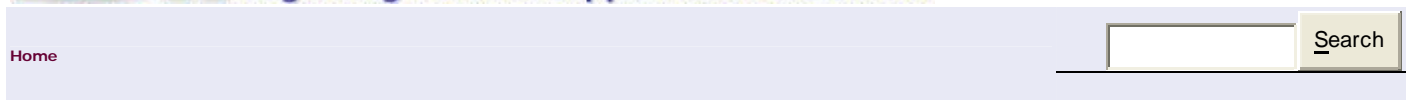
### 2009-2010

To be officially registered to participate in our SCOE BTSA program you **must** complete the consent registration with the state. It is imperative that each FIRST YEAR participating teacher and EARLY COMPLETION OPTION candidate get online and take just a few minutes to register. Year two participants do not need to register as your information is being carried over from the previous year.

All Support Providers **must** also complete the consent registration now via the State BTSA website. SPs will be asked to participate in the state survey in early spring.

All PTs and SPs **must** be registered **by September 16, 2009**. Any PT not registered with the state will not be funded and may be held personally accountable by their district.
