

# DISTRICT ASSISTANCE AND INTERVENTION TEAMS

## DAIT

**Purpose:** To provide services as a State-approved District Assessment and Intervention Team (DAIT) for districts requiring State monitoring. The Stanislaus County Office of Education DAIT works with the District Leadership Team (DLT) to:

- Examine current practices at both the district and school levels
- Evaluate the effectiveness of those practices
- Identify and prioritize the district's major areas of need
- Develop and implement actions that target those needs

**Targeted Audience:** Districts in Program Improvement Year 3.

**Format:** The district enters into an agreement with the Stanislaus COE to fulfill the role established by the State for DAIT providership. Working with the District DAIT Team, the Stanislaus COE DAIT staff utilizes the California Department of Education's tools:

- District Assessment Survey (DAS)
- Academic Program Survey (APS)
- English Learner Subgroup Self Assessment (ELSSA)
- Least Restrictive Environment (LRE)

**Cost:** To be determined by State legislation and/or MOU agreements.

**Additional Notes:**

The cost of the DAIT providership may include support services that follow the identification of the corrective actions should Stanislaus COE staff provide those services, especially in the form of professional development offered to the school staff.
