SCOE Hosts the Stanislaus County Area Manufacturing Maintenance Joint Apprenticeship Program Workshop

The Stanislaus County Office of Education (SCOE) is hosting the **Stanislaus County Area Manufacturing Maintenance Joint Apprenticeship Program Workshop on December 12 and 13, 2014** at the **Stanislaus Industrial Technology Institute** (635 Walnut Avenue, Patterson).

The workshop will include four breakout sessions on Friday (8:30 a.m. – 3:45 p.m.) and two sessions on Saturday (8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.) Students from the Stanislaus Industrial Technology Institute will shadow the presenters and participate in the hands-on activities. Workshop sessions include: Belts and Belt Lacing, Conveyers, Motors, Gear Boxes, and Vibration Analysis.

According to Superintendent Tom Changnon, this workshop is designed to help increase student awareness of the Apprenticeship Program. “Students attending the hands-on workshop will have a unique opportunity to learn about the partnership with the Stanislaus County Area Manufacturing Maintenance Joint Apprenticeship Program and hear from experts in each classification relating to maintenance,” said Changnon.
