Careers in Education Day and Substitute Teacher's Recruitment Fair on Saturday, August 8

The Stanislaus County Office of Education (SCOE) is hosting a **Career's in Education Day on Saturday, August 8 from 8:30 a.m. - noon** at SCOE's Martin Petersen Event Center (720 12th Street, Modesto). The Careers in Education Day and Substitute Teacher's Recruitment Fair is open to anyone interested in learning what it takes to become a professional educator in California who would like to teach or to substitute teach.

Local central valley colleges will be onsite as well as SCOE's Intern program providing the information on educational programs and college requirements to get credentialed. Information on current grants and financial assistance for college will also be available.

Five school districts, including SCOE, will be on hand to fill substitute teaching positions for the 2015-16 school year. Participating districts include: Modesto City Schools, Sylvan Union, Turlock Unified and Waterford Unified. On-site interviews will be conducted.

Colleges attending include Brandman University, Cal State Teacher, CSU Stanislaus, Grand Canyon and Teacher College of San Joaquin.

Three FREE 30 minute workshops will be held throughout the morning. Workshop topics include:

- Tips on Classroom Management
- CBEST – California Basic Skills Test Preparation
