Teacher Recruitment Fair Slated for Saturday, March 21

The Stanislaus County Office of Education (SCOE) is hosting a **Teacher Recruitment Fair** on **Saturday, March 21 from 8:30 a.m. - noon** at SCOE's downtown offices, 1100 H Street, Modesto. This year's fair is open to *fully-credentialed teachers* or *intern-eligible candidates, credential completion candidates* by August 2015 (verified by Program Completion letter or Intern Eligible letter) who pre-register on-line by Wednesday, March 18, 2015 at www.edjoin.org. Admission is free. (Candidates who do not pre-register will be admitted into the fair at 10:00 a.m.)

Fourteen school districts, SCOE, along with private and charter schools, will be on hand to fill positions for the 2015-16 school year. Participating schools/districts include: Aspire Charter Public, Big Valley Christian, Delhi Unified, Fusion charter, Great Valley Charter, Hart Ransom Union, Hughson Unified, Keyes Union, Modesto City Schools, Newman Crows Landing Unified, Oakdale Joint Unified, Patterson Joint Unified, Riverbank Unified, Sonora Union, Sierra Vista, Stanislaus County Office of Education (Educational Options and Special Education), Stanislaus Union, Sylvan Union, Turlock Unified and Waterford Unified. On-site interviews will be conducted.

Other schools attending include Brandman University and Teacher College of San Joaquin.
