Sponsored by the **Stanislaus County Office of Education (SCOE)** and supported by the **Education Foundation of Stanislaus County**, many of the events are open to the public beginning at 8:30 a.m. This year, spectator events include: Bridge Building, Can Race, Paddle Boat, Propeller Propulsion, Orienteering, Straw Egg Drop and Water Rockets.
