

Academic Decathlon Objective Test

Challenge Procedure

- 1) Questions are context specific due to national participation in this test. Students should not be looking for ANY plausible answer, but the BEST answer, based on the text provided. Often the most obvious or direct answer is NOT provided (much in the same fashion as the ACT, SAT or any AP exam), requiring the student to determine the BEST response.

- 2) According to the CAD Challenge Procedures and Guidelines, the challenge of a test item on an objective test may be lodged during the competition by a coach because of one of the following reasons only:
 - A. No correct answer
 - B. Two equally correct answers
 - C. Typographical error found in the text of the question

- 3) Challenges to any item on an objective test for any reason other than those stated above will not be considered. All decisions made by the Stanislaus County Academic Decathlon Executive Committee are final.
