## Super Quiz (SQ) March-in & Relay Instructions

### **March-in (begins at 1:20, line up at 1:15)**

Teams will march in from back of gym (one side only). Coaches will pick up team signs in the Gym near the SQ entrance door. Once coaches have their team situated in correct order, please take your seat in the Gym. A list indicating "March In" order will be posted near the SQ entrance door and on the Super Quiz Diagram. Teams will be announced in order. The sign can be carried by the first student leading the team inside the gym.

The three varsity students will take their seat on the floor and the rest of the team will join their coach in the spectator chairs on the floor or bleachers (coaches please stand up so your team knows where to sit). **ALL team members may march in including Alternate Team Members.**

### **Seating**

The event coordinators have determined seating in the bleachers for teams. Signs will be placed on the bleachers to mark each team's seating area.

**Seating assignments remain the same for the Awards Ceremony** (following the break).

### **Super Quiz Oral Relay (1:40 – 3:00 PM approximate times):**

1. Decathletes from the three academic categories will compete. Varsity Decathletes will compete first; followed by Scholastic Decathletes, and finally the Honor Decathletes.
2. Each team will have up to three (3) Decathletes represented in each of the three categories.
3. As each group takes their place on the floor, they will be able to communicate with one another regarding the question but will individually answer each question.
4. Decathletes may begin quietly discussing the question with their team once the MC begins reading the question.
5. Teams will be granted an additional 10 seconds after the last distractor ("e") has been read for all questions with the exception for the two math questions. Math questions will be an additional 20 seconds.
6. After the correct response is given the proctor will hold up a paddle with a number on it corresponding with the number of correct responses for that question (1, 2, or 3).
7. The steps are repeated for 14 questions per division (varsity, scholastic, and then honors).

**Challenges:** Super Quiz Relay challenges can be made **up to fifteen minutes after the event**. A challenge to a question must be accompanied by the published correct information.
