We understand that the primary goals of History Day are to promote student learning, foster intellectual development, and develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills. As teacher/coach and principal at this school, we agree to monitor student progress and to review all entries for historical accuracy and overall quality.

As a condition of participation in the Stanislaus County History Day, each student will be required to sign a Code of Ethics statement (included on the permission slip) affirming that the entry submitted for competition was researched and developed during the current school year. In addition, the Code of Ethics will affirm that all research, design and development for the entry was student-produced. As a teacher/coach or principal involved in the History Day event, I agree that I will be courteous and model good sportsmanship at all times. I am aware that the decision of the judges is final. I will respect the judges' decisions and discuss any concerns with the event coordinator in a respectful manner. We understand that this signed agreement form and a complete set of signed student/parent agreement forms (one for each student with both parent/guardian and student signatures) must be received by the due date to the coordinator in order to participate in the Stanislaus County History Day.
