The Stanislaus County Scholarship Advisory Committee is pleased to announce that the Corey Sean Norby Memorial Scholarship will be made available again this year to a graduating senior who qualifies.

Students from Modesto City High Schools (*Beyer, Davis, Downey, Enochs, Gregori, Johansen and Modesto High*) are eligible to apply. Students will attend Modesto Junior College and follow a pathway with the goal of transferring to a 4 year college to earn a degree to work with children in teaching, counseling, or coaching in preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. A grade point average of 3.0 or higher and at least 1 year of team sport participation (includes cheerleading).

## **Criteria and Scholarship Information**

1. The Scholarship Advisory Committee will annually award the scholarship.
2. The amount of the scholarship will be \$500.
3. A scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from Modesto City High Schools.
4. Applicants shall have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher during their junior and senior years.
5. A minimum of one scholarship will be offered each year.
6. Application deadline for students will be March 27, 2020. The scholarship will be announced the first week in May.
